What has been accomplished

- > Presentation of context and vision
- > Presentation of a lot of information, celebrating many successes and recognizing actual challenges.
- > Opportunity for asking questions, raising concerns and discussing
- > 116 options identified internally + 45 issues or questions raised during the 2 days external workshop.

Proposal for next steps



Before the end of 2005 :

- 1) Presentation of the **2005 projects and planned activities**, covering approx. 57 issues of the 116 internally identified (50%)
 - Formally rate all the issues brought internally
 - 2) If not included in 1), Presentation of the committed or potential action(s) for all :
 - **HIGH Legal** (21)
 - **HIGH Severity** (19)
 - **HIGH Public concern** (9) ** Validate
 - Total : 34 issues
- > This could constitute the 2005 part of the P2 plan
- 3) After time for stakeholders to review it, acceptance of the prioritization criteria used in the ranking matrix.

Proposal for next steps



For a PAC meeting in May 2005 (before 2006 budgeting) :

3) If not included in 1 or 2), Scoping all the **Quick Returns** and **Maximized Environmental Value Issues**.

A decision will then be taken, as if an action will be engaged or not, and when. Review of the 2006 priorities and adjustment of the budget accordingly.

For a PAC meeting in May 2006 (before 2007 budgeting) :

4) If not included in 1 or 2 or 3), Scope out all the **Long Term Investigative Options** and reevaluate the **Low Value Options**.

A decision will then be taken, as if an action will be engaged or not, and when. Review of the 2007 priorities and adjustment of the budget accordingly.

P2 annual review



- > P2 accomplishments and planned activities should be reviewed annually, formally, in May (before budgeting period).
- > Targets should be reviewed annually.
- > Review of the list of issues should be reviewed (with prioritized categories as proposed in the 2 previous slides) and if new issues arise, they should be ranked using the accepted method.
- > The actions envisaged for the next year, clearly scoped and documented, will be brought to the management team for financial support (budget established in early September).
